Eligible renewable energy projects:

How a renewable energy lease agreement works:



A lease agreement is formed between you (the customer) and WRB Energy, the renewable energy developer/financer, at no upfront cost to you.

WRB develops, finances, owns, maintains, and insures the renewable energy system. You, the customer, pay a monthly amount to lease the system and benefit from the lower energy costs produced by the system.





The term of the lease is 5 to 20 years. At the end of the term, you can 1) buy the system for a nominal amount, 2) leave the system in place and extend an agreement at a reduced rate or, 3) have the system removed.
